

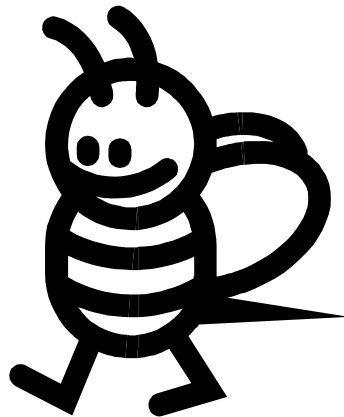


Father's Day –
